## WHY DAY & NIGHT PRAYER & WORSHIP?

**1.** Worship Invites God's Presence Into a Place and God's Presence Changes Everything



God inhabits the praises of His people (Ps. 22:30)



Moses understood the necessity of God's Presence and was unwilling to live without it (Ex. 33:15-16)

**2.** Prayer Releases God's Kingdom to Come and His Will to be Done, On Earth as it is in Heaven



Jesus taught His disciples to pray in this way (Matt. 6:10)

**3.** Nothing of Eternal Significance Comes Forth Apart from Abiding Prayer (Jn. 15:4-8, 16)



ALL fruitfulness flows from abiding in Christ. Then we will bear much fruit - fruit that *remains*!

4. God Always Intended His House To Be "A House of Prayer For All Nations" (Isa. 56:7)



God's desire has always been that His presence would be accessible to *all people*, at *all times!* 

5. God's Desire is that the Fire on the Altar Would Never Go Out – In our Hearts, Homes & Communities



"The fire must be kept burning on the altar continuously; it must not go out." (Lev. 6:13)



God's Word instructs to "Pray Without Ceasing" (1 Thess. 5:17)

# 6. Day & Night Prayer Releases Justice on the Earth



"And will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him *day and night?...* I tell you, he will *give justice...speedily.*" (Lk. 18:7-8)

7. Historically, Day & Night Prayer Has Been Key in Hosting God's Presence – Both in Birthing & Sustaining Revival



# 8. It Is A Fulfillment of Biblical Prophecy & A Key For the Harvest in the Last Days



David set up a continual hosting of God's presence through *day* & *night* worship, prayer & sacrificial offerings (1 Chron. 6:31-32; 9:33; 16:1, 4-6, 37, 39-40; 23:30-31)



Amos 9:11-12  $\rightarrow$  God declares HE will restore the tabernacle of David, to draw the nations to Himself!

#### **9.** It Is An Expression of Heaven on Earth



"Day and night they never stop saying, 'Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come.'" (Rev. 4:8)

## **10.** Jesus Is Worthy Of It



"Worthy is the Lamb, who was slain, to receive ...praise & honor & glory & power, for ever & ever!"



(Rev. 5:12-13) He is worthy of the worship of every heart & soul!
